


## What Is It That God, Jesus Christ, And The Holy Ghost Have In Common With Simple Plain Water?




2 Timothy 2:15
<sup>15</sup> Study to shew thyself approved unto God, a workman that needeth not to be ashamed, rightly dividing the word of truth.

Water is a very interesting substance, and it has three different states of existence. It can be a Solid, a Liquid, or a Gas



Using the same example let's take a look at what is known as the doctrine of the Trinity.



The hardest part about understanding this doctrine is understanding how it is possible for three different entities to be the same as stated in I John 5:7 of the King James Bible, The Douay-Rheims 1899 American Edition of the Bible, The 1599 Geneva Bible, The Wycliffe Bible as well as others. <sup>7</sup> For there are three that bear record in heaven, the Father, the Word, and the Holy Ghost: and these three are one.

Is there some way that we can physically show that three different things can actually be the same all at the same time? The answer is yes, and that is where water comes into play.



It is actually very easy to show and prove it is possible by taking a pot of hot water out into sub-zero temperatures and throwing it out into the air. The water will very quickly condenses in the cold air as a cloud of visible "steam" (micro-droplets of water) which then very quickly freezes into a dust cloud of tiny ice crystals (a solid).
